This wasn't the case at all; from our very first meeting with Joseph Mercieca, we knew we had made the right decision. Joseph gave us his total attention and we discussed every detail. He was able to provide the contacts, there and then, for all the services we required, from the flowers to the DJ to the cake and even a lovely lady who provides wedding decorations specifically made for Country Terrace, which were certainly worth the extra euros because the place looked like a magical scene for our wedding.
